Pesach Planner

Some interesting updates, as per our 2026 Pesach Planner:

Alert Update – Folgers Decaf Coffee – Decaffeinated coffee from Folgers is no longer acceptable for Pesach due to a change in the decaffeination process that occurred over the past year.

However, containers that were purchased before last Pesach and set aside with Pesach products may still be used. Any Folgers decaf purchased after Pesach last year should not be used for Pesach.

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Policy Update – Virgin Coconut Oil – The Orthodox Union (OU) has reverted to its previous policy regarding virgin coconut oil.

Virgin coconut oil is acceptable for Pesach with regular OU certification. Special Kosher for Passover certification is not required.

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Kirkland Purified Water with added minerals – As per our continued discussion with the OU, Kirkland Purified Water (with minerals added for taste) is acceptable for use on Pesach this year (2026), *provided that it is purchased before Pesach.*

March 13, 2026 JOYVA - Pesach Clarification from the Kof K

While Joyva products are certified by Kof K during the year, Joyva chocolate-covered jelly rings and Joyva marshmallow twists that bear a "K for Passover" designation, are not certified by the KOF-K. Several of the ingredients used in the manufacturing of these products are highly sensitive for Pesach, with potential kitniyos and/or chametz-related concerns. Accordingly, the KOF-K does not endorse, certify, or recommend these products for Pesach use, even for individuals who customarily consume kitniyos on Pesach.
